It doesn't host the content but


gives a fast and easy interface

- Platform to inform on online contents
 - mainly journals from french platforms like cairn.info, érudit, persée, revues.org and other disseminated french journals
 - but also selected international journals in open access or subscribed by members libraries
- Many other editorial information
- Collaborative network useful to libraries, researchers and publishers







Our data

- → Free access to our website since 2008
- → Opendata policy being now adopted with project of new *Licence* Ouverte from French governement
- → ...but needs to be implemented with a new API first step available : http://reseau-mirabel.info/api

Data from others

→ Re-use opendata or link data that others product better

❖ Shared watch = added value

Automatic collection

- → Daily updates from the main resources (1260 journals concerned)
- → Weekly updates regarding other links (HELOISE, DOAJ, ROAD ...)
- → Sherpa/RoMEO only: API request on the fly is done (due to limitation with current API)
- → Automated updates set up on demand

Manual additions assumed by the partners

Updates proposed by users

- → Web Interface opened to users for additional information
- → Moderation by Mir@bel network

Next sources to automate

- Bacon (French national licenses and other stuff)

- Mir@bel: a few figures
 - Created in 2008
 - > 47 partners
 - ➤ 3676 journals (57% providing free full text for some periods)
 - > 1334 updates imported daily automatically
 - > 12 automated sources (for content access or data linking)
